

Wisconsin Builders Foundation Matching Grant Scholarship Application

Application Due Date: Local associations should forward their application packets to the Wisconsin Builders Foundation after their scholarship selection has been made. Applications will be accepted starting February 1st until May 31st of each year.

Scholarship Amounts: Up to \$1,000.

Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates for the matching grant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a United States citizen and Wisconsin resident.
- Have a minimum 2.5 g.p.a.
- Must be enrolled or accepted into a Wisconsin or Minnesota institute of higher education in their building trades program.
- Be awarded a scholarship at the local association level

Application Specifications:

The local association will forward each recipient's completed application packet along with the association's selection criteria and reason for recommendation. At a minimum, the application packet should include:

- Local association scholarship application
- High school/college transcripts (verified by local association)
- Work and volunteer history
- Name of the Wisconsin or Minnesota institute of higher learning and program of study
- One-page, typed essay as required by the local association

OR

• A written essay or video responding to the following topic:

WHAT FACTORS INFLUENCED YOU TO PURSUE A CAREER IN THE BUILDING TRADES?

Selection Process:

The Wisconsin Builders Foundation Trustees will select the scholarship winners. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Winners will be notified by the Wisconsin Builders Foundation. Awards will be presented at the WBA summer meeting each year.
